

Field Practicum Agencies

The MSU Social Work Program maintains established partnerships with a variety of community agencies that provide field practicum opportunities for our students. In addition, several approved field practicum opportunities are available within the Mississippi State University campus environment. The Program continuously works to maintain existing partnerships and develop new practicum opportunities to expand placement options for students. The table below provides a sample (abbreviated) list of agencies and organizations that may serve as field practicum sites for social work students.
